


Personal support for serious care

For referrals, talk to your doctor.

Your employer plan requires you to select a primary care doctor for a referral. They are a great resource and should know the in-network specialists who are right for you.

Log in as a member, or a guest, and note your employer plan is

"EPO Plus/Open Access EPO Plus."

You can also call the 800-number on the back of your ID card and one of our concierge team members will be happy to help you.



Get a check-up — they're covered

Don't put off preventative and routine care if you're worried about costs. Your Texas Health Aetna plan benefits cover a range of free or low cost services, including:

- + Routine adult physical exams and immunizations
- + Routine well child exams
- + Childhood immunizations
- + Routine gynecological care
- + Routine mammograms (one per year for women age 35 and over)
- + Women's Health (see right)
- + Routine Digital Rectal/Prostate Specific Antigen Test (recommended for men age 40 and over)
- + Colorectal cancer screening (ages 45 and over)
- + Routine eye exams (1 exam every 24 months)
- + Routine hearing screening

Covered preventative care for women

Among the deductible waived* women's health services provided are:

- + Screening for gestational diabetes
- + HPV (human papilloma virus)
- + DNA testing
- + Counseling for sexually transmitted infections
- + Counseling and screening for human immunodeficiency virus
- + Screening and counseling for interpersonal and domestic violence
- + Breastfeeding support, supplies and counseling
- + Contraceptive methods, patient education and counseling
- * Limitations may apply. Deductible waived means for preventative services, you only pay the copay.

- + Save time and money compared to Urgent Care or the ER (average cost: \$2,500).
- + Stay healthy with check-ups, routine and preventive care, tests and screenings.
- + Use telehealth/video consults if you can't make a visit.
- + Get referrals to the right in-network experts for chronic conditions.

- + Walk-in and same day/next day appointments
- + Annual exams, health screenings and immunizations
- + Sports physicals

- + Healthy-lifestyle education
